Welcome to Philadelphia, the place to b.y.o.be!

Soon the bring-your-own-bottle (BYOB) restaurant will be as synonymous with Philadelphia as the cheesesteak, the soft pretzel and Rocky. Typically cozy, family-run, laid-back—and all about the food—BYOBs can be found around most every corner of Center City and tucked down country roads (at last count, more than 200).

Why BYOB?:

Historians have yet to come up with the name of the region's very first BYOB, but modern restaurant experts agree the phenomenon developed as a result of Pennsylvania's strict liquor laws and high liquor taxation. When start-up restaurants choose to forgo the expenses of owning a liquor license, they lower their initial overhead, which lets them keep menu prices lower, which, in turn, attracts a wider range of clientele. Today, the spirit of the BYOB celebrates this level of freedom and casualness. Like the brasserie, the café and the gastropub, the BYOB has evolved into its own genre, and consumers like being in charge. At a BYOB, diners get to drink exactly what they want to drink without draining the budget and without sacrificing quality.

BYOB Etiquette:

BYOBs rarely stand for fussy manners. Most permit jeans. Brown-bagging chardonnay is universally accepted, as is substituting wine for beer. Still, there are a few ground rules:

#1: Use this guide to learn reservation policies, as the rules vary widely. One spot may allow reservations during the week but not on weekends. Another may allow you to call ahead and place your name on a waiting list. And many will gladly find you at the bar across the street when your table is ready.

#2: Most BYOBs will not ask you to open your own bottle.

#3: Many BYOBs are cash only. Use this handy guide to find out if you need to stop at an ATM on the way!

Fun Facts

- Not only was the **Jamaican Jerk Hut** featured in the film *In Her Shoes*, but director Curtis Hanson also selected the restaurant's owner, Nicola Shirley, to prepare the food that was on camera. At the end of the day's shooting, stars Cameron Diaz and Toni Collette joined Hanson in polishing off the cuisine.
- The owner of the **High Street Caffe** was formerly the member of a rock band, and members of the rock groups Cinderella and Ratt frequently dine in the restaurant.
- The Orchard features custom-milled mahogany lockers, where guests can stow their own preferred spirits. The staff maintains a register based on the contents of each locker, which is kept on file so guests can receive an up-to-date personal wine list with each visit.
